

# The Leathers We Use

## VT Leather

VT or Vegetable tanned leather is named because of the natural tannins used in the tanning process. Made from CHROME free wet white hides which are ecologically tanned. i.e. tanned with all natural chemicals which are not harmful giving it a classic leather smell.



## Oil & Wax Pull Up Leather



Pull Up Leather is one of our most used classic leathers that we offer due to its high quality and beautiful natural appearance. Pull Up leather is oil and wax rich, giving it a soft, supple and waxy touch and feel.

It generally has a natural appearance which lightens in colour when stretched. Over time it gives a unique worn-in effect. Due to this soft and scratch-sensitive finish, the leather quickly gets a beautiful vintage-patina which is unique to each user. Rewax it to remove the scratches and make it look new.

## Hunter Leather

Rugged waxed polished leather which is processed to give a vintage look. Being an oil waxed leather it is nearly impossible to maintain the same colours from batch to batch. This results in a rustic looking leather with a firm, velvety feel, which gets a natural patina after short use. Over usage the leather darkens giving it a more elegant rich look.



## Savage Leather

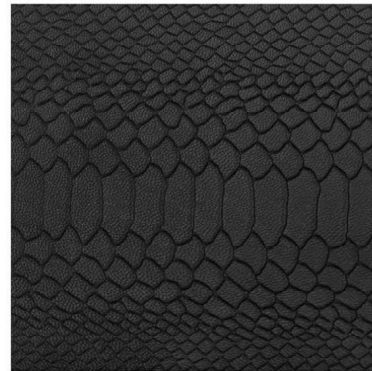


This is one of our signature leathers. SAVAGE as the name says is a leather that is heavily oiled and fine milled. It has a thickness of around 1.4mm with most characteristics of an oil pull up leather. Over a period of usage the leather develops a rustic used look which strongly justifies our brand.

## Printed Anaconda Leather

Snake scale pattern is embossed on an oil pull up leather giving the characteristics of an anaconda skin.

You can feel the embossed scale when you feel the leather giving it a beautiful look when the product is made.



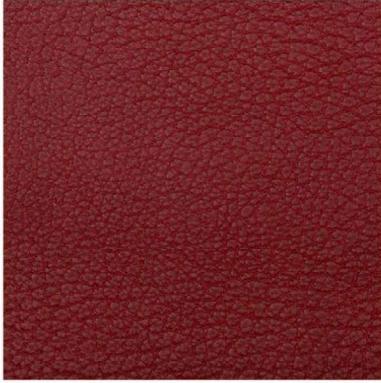
## Washed Leather



Washed leather are drum dyed and tumble washed thus giving a soft and aged appearance to the leather.

# Pebbled Grain Leather



Pebbled grain leather has a characteristic patina that resembles that of pebbles owing to its name.

The texture is very pleasant, and is often made in soft leathers. Since it creates raised areas on the surface, the leather is less prone to scratching and marks from abrasions. Bags made from this leather when well cared-for, can last decades. It also stands up well to daily use. Mostly used for fashion products.

# Nappa Leather

Napa is a full grain premium leather with a soft feel and buttery touch. It is lightweight and has a thickness of 0.9-1.2mm.

Nappa leather can be cleaned generally by rubbing with a moist, lint-free cloth over the surface. It comes in a wide range of colors.



# Crunch Leather



Light and snuffed oil pulled leather is finished of with a PU protein on the top to give it a beautiful and long lasting sheen.

It is waxy to touch and feel giving it a vintage look. The leather is easy to care for, and it gets smoother the more you use it. It has a thickness of around 1.4mm and used in products like
